Summer Internship New Castle United for Youth Town of New Castle

Are you a teen between the ages of 14 and 18 who lives in New Castle? Are you looking for a summer opportunity where you can work with other teens, learn new skills and make an impact in your community? If you answered yes to any of these questions, the New Castle United for Youth Summer Internship may be for you.

New Castle United for Youth is looking for high school students to work as summer interns with our federally funded community-based youth prevention coalition. Summer interns will work with our Student Internship Coordinator, Coalition members and other professionals on topics related to leadership skills and prevention work. Possible topics may include understanding the impact of alcohol and other drug use on our bodies and athletic performance, designing and communicating messages regarding making healthy choices, planning and implementing fun activities for teens and using social media, websites and other platforms to engage teens.

Summer internship work will be divided into three sessions to accomodate other summer activities. Applicants may apply for one, two, or all three sessions. Each session will consist of six group internship work sessions, two to three times per week from 10 am to noon. Interns may need to complete some additional preparatory work or complete tasks outside of group meeting hours. Interns who successfully complete a session by putting in the necessary number of hours and completing assigned tasks will receive an internship stipend of \$120. We can accomodate up to ten interns per session.
